

Lowell Relay Quartet Sets Meet Record

Lowell High's two-mile relay team of Pete Reider, Al Bullock, Don Brown and Tom Leonard set a meet record of 8:27.2 in the Martinez Relays yesterday on Alhambra High Field. The old record was 8:33.9.

Berkeley won the meet with 22 points, followed by Richmond at 20 and Washington of San Francisco with 17. A total of 32 schools entered the meet.

Other outstanding performances were turned in by Balboa's Jack Egan, who threw the college discus 139-10 to anchor his team's victory, and the 6-1 high jump of Lowell's Phil Fehlen and Bob Arteberry of Washington. Washington won the event. St. Ignatius' Lee Olds tossed the shot 49-1 $\frac{3}{4}$ to lead his team's victory in this event.
